No. 12/2024 of Academic Council Meeting held on 14.06.2024 for giving suggestions regarding implementation 'First Interim Report and Recommendations' in the University, received from the Hon'ble Governor & Chancellor for uniform implementation of the NEP- 2020.

AND whereas, the matter is of an urgent nature and any further delay in time will result against the academic interest of University as well as the students.

I, Professor Kanhaiya Lal Shrivastava, Vice-Chancellor, Jai Narain Vyas University, Jodhpur in exercise of powers vested in me under Section 12(5) of the Act of Jai Narain Vyas University, Jodhpur, hereby approved as under (Point No. 5 of the Interim Report) :

To adopt the examination scheme of 20% weightage for Continuous Assessment (C.A.) : 80% weightage for End of Semester Examination (EoSE) of total marks instead of existing Examination Scheme of 30% weightage (C.A.): 70% weightage (EoSE) of total marks in the Undergraduate and Postgraduate Courses based on the National Education Policy - 2020 of the University for student who are admitted in the University in Academic Session 2024-2025 & onwards. Detailed scheme is as follows:
